スマウト教授を京都大学にお迎えするのは2度目になります(前回はもう10年ほど前になるように思います)。久しぶりの再会を楽しみにしています。なお、講演用のペーパーが届いていますので、必要な方は請求をしてください。

Professor Chris Smout is Scotland's most celebrated historian, and Historiographer Royal. He first taught in Scotland in 1959 when he joined the newly-formed department of Economic History at Edinburgh as assistant lecturer. He remained there, eventually becoming Professor of Economic History, until 1980, when he moved to the chair of Scottish History at St Andrews, starting a new department. He retired from teaching in 2000. His best known contributions have been to social history, notably The History of the Scottish People (1969) and The Century of the Scottish People (1986). He has also written extensively on demographic history and many aspects of economic history. Since the mid-1990s, he has developed the new discipline of environmental history in Scotland, giving the Ford Lectures in Oxford in 1999, published under the title of Nature Contested, Environmental History in Scotland and Northern England since 1600. His most recent publications in this field have been in woodland history. He served for 14 years on the Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments of Scotland, and he has been a member of the Royal Commission on Historical Manuscripts, of the Trustees of the National Museums of Scotland and of the board of Scottish Natural Heritage, where he was deputy chairman. He has lectured in China, Japan, USA, Canada and Australia.
